Question was asked, if commercial common plan of development (cannot be covered under CPODP) had been constructed, does each lot need its own permit? Discussion lead to definition of common plan of development is, "An idea or plan to subdivide and make money on individual lots". So answer is yes, if meets definition. However, once those lots are built on, finished and sold for their intended purpose, they are no longer part of the permit.
