Mission Statement: The Utah Storm Water Advisory Committee will coordinate efforts to reduce storm water pollution and provide adequate flood control. The committee will jointly review governing regulations, disseminate information to enhance compliance with those regulated, promote effective storm water management training, and assist local municipalities and other interested parties to implement best management practices, consistent with their individual needs and resources. The committee will also review any proposed storm water regulations to assess potential impacts on the regulated community.

3. Review and approval of the minutes from the **Aug 9, 2017** meeting.
Motion made to amend "Escalating Settlement Offer" to "Expedited Settlement Offer" and run spell check. Motion to approve by George Burbidge. and seconded by Blane Frandsen.
4. Discussion on Input for Construction General Permit Renewal.
 - a. *Harry: Beginning now to review the Construction General Permit (CGP) for renewal. It will expire at the end of June 2019. Consider the possibility of the CGP and the Common Plan Permit being combined into one permit consisting of two parts. It may be based on types of construction (i.e. heavy excavating, linear projects, individual lot work, vertical construction, etc.) Please give feedback and ideas.*
 - b. *Paul: Many cities are confused about the role of the two permits.*
 - c. *Harry: The qualifying questions on the website application make it difficult to choose the permit you want. The questions will be removed and replaced with a selection of which permit you want with a brief description of each permit.*
 - d. *Blane: Thanks for addressing these comments; will there be a clause that Permittees will agree to the Expedited Settlement Offer (ESO)?*
 - e. *Harry: ESO is a separate, enforcement tool; there are other options such as a letter or NOV that can also be used. We want to keep them separate. I want to hear from inspectors and people on the front lines to make the permit better. If you think of something send an email hcampbell@utah.gov*

- f. *Paul: It would be a good thing to distribute the comments to all and allow discussion.*
 - g. *Justin: We will leave this discussion item, to review the CGP, on the agenda for the next several months.*

If you are making changes there is a process to follow in the permit of how to update the SWMP. The updated version should be on your website. - a. DWQ Programs and EPA by Jeanne Riley:
 - a. *The revisions to the room make it less accommodating for the style of meeting we have. Options are being researched. We need space for 50-70 people and located in the Salt Lake Valley. If you have a meeting place suggestion, forward it to Justin.*
 - b. *Annual Reports are due Oct. 1st*
 - c. *Division as part of all of DEQ is reviewing the fees, the comment period closed September 11th and a fee hearing was held for the July 2018-June 2019 fiscal year. Fees are proposed to increase for:*
 - Construction \$150 to \$250,*
 - Industrial \$150 to \$250,*
 - No exposure waiver \$100 to \$150,*
 - Low erosivity waiver \$50 to \$100,*
 - MS4's per population:*
