5. State of Utah Updates:
  - a. DWQ Programs and EPA by Jeff Studenka: *Region 8 Stormwater Contact has changed from Greg Davis with Amy Clarke. EPA published a Notice of Intent to renew their own Construction General Permit (45 day comment period). Our permit closely mirrors their permit. State is working on their part of the ongoing statewide nutrient reduction strategy effort.*
  - b. Municipal Program by Rhonda Thiele: *Those permittees that have submitted audit responses that include timelines need to be sure to submit information to the State as those tasks are completed. Happy with the amount of interaction regarding permit discussion and questions via emails and calls.*

- c. Industrial Program by Mike George: *Working to permit mineral and metal mines. Prioritized by proximity to water.*
  - d. Construction Program by Harry Campbell: *There are still some issues with the database, but they will be worked out. Making revisions in the Construction General Permit, no major changes. Trying to match the stabilization standards and NOT process with the Common Plan Permit. If you would like to see the current draft contact Harry.*
  - e. Storm Water Program by Jeanne Riley: *Busy with outreach activities with the various Coalitions for the new Permit. If you would like Jeanne to visit your Coalition, contact her.*
