7. State of Utah Updates:

- a. DWQ Programs and EPA by Jeff Studenka – *Provided clarification on the nutrient rule. E-reporting rule, the EPA is on track to announce it later this year. Requirement to submit annual reports electronically, likely will be required in two years.*
- b. Municipal Program by Rhonda Thiele: - *UDOT and MS4 General Permits will be out in approximately one week. Will have two weeks to review and provide comments, this is just a stakeholder review. There will be a more formal review public comment period later.*
- c. Industrial Program by Mike George: - *EPA adopted the Multisector General Permit (MSGP) last week. Mike is working on a MSGP for Utah, monitoring requirements will change.*
- d. Construction Program by Harry Campbell: - *Common Plan Permit going to notice in 2-3 weeks. After that Harry will work on the Construction General Permit. Will be working on an expedited settlement conference document.*
- e. Storm Water Program by Jeanne Riley: *Nothing to report.*
