Mission Statement: The Utah Storm Water Advisory Committee will coordinate efforts to reduce storm water pollution and provide adequate flood control. The committee will jointly review governing regulations, disseminate information to enhance compliance with those regulated, promote effective storm water management training, and assist local municipalities and other interested parties to implement best management practices, consistent with their individual needs and resources. The committee will also review any proposed storm water regulations to assess potential impacts on the regulated community.

- e. Storm Water Program by Jeanne Riley:
Remember to submit your NOIs for the MS4 permit, they were due Jan. 31 for the future permit. She stated that there are a few MS4s that have not submitted their NOIs yet.
- f. Storm Water Program by Monique Rodriguez:
Contact her about expired NOTs. The Chairman added that Monique Rodriguez and Harry Campbell will be presenting the procedures to close a NOI and the paperwork required with the submittal of the NOT.

11. USWAC Subcommittees Updates:

a. Industrial:

If your city has a lot of industrial sites, it is recommended you get involved to help you understand and to help the rest of the USWAC to benefit from your knowledge.

b. Post Construction:

Still reviewing the Post-Const inspection forms, to provide to Harry and then share with members of USWAC.

c. R.S.I. Program:

Deadline to register is 24-hours before class. You can't just show up with a check anymore, you must sign up through the APWA website. The next RSI training class is being hosted by Davis County on March 18th 2015 and the next training class will be host by Washington County Storm Water Coalition on April 29th 2015.

12. APWA News and Updates:

Call for presentations ongoing and are due by end of April. Need 24 presentations. State will take care of the MS4 track. Submit your own presentation or a presentation by others you recommend. You may also recommend a stormwater keynote speaker for the 3 tracks to start the conference.

13. Stormwater Coalitions News and Updates:

a. Cache County:

Last month elected an alternate USWAC voter: Mike Grunich from Hyde Park City. Stormwater packets being prepared and re-ordered. Assignment given for developing a website.

b. Davis County:

SW training class last month taught by Stantec about 85 attended. RSI in North Salt Lake on the 18th of March. Water Fair April 22-23 for 4th graders at the Davis County Fairgrounds. Endless supply of videos relating to stormwater on YouTube.

c. Salt Lake County: *Water Fair May 13-14 at Hogle Zoo, working to setup an RSI training.*

d. Utah County: *133 in attendance for the Utah County Stormwater Coalition Annual Conference. There were two sessions. One session was related to educating contractors about updates on the Construction General Permit. The second session included two presentations about Low Impact Development.*

e. Washington County:

Last month trained 6 in RSI, there is a future training planned; waiting for public comment period for the single-lot permit. Working on training and public outreach PSAs through local radio station.

f. Weber County:

Health Department is participating more and bringing many good resources. Contractor training on April 8th at West Haven. The Water Fair has been scheduled for April 15-16. Subcommittee to work on interlocal agreement. Harrisville City has developed a small-site SWPPP, waiting to see the new CPOD permit.

Candice Cady: update to last presentation: received a plethora of phone calls after training. Questions about EPA and UIC wells. Asked Jason Deardorf at EPA: monitoring storm drainage detention wells? "We don't know of anyone moving towards monitoring or inspecting discharges to storm water drainage wells." There still are UPDES standards/requirements. You need to follow the UIC rules and BMPs

(which are being created, along with a website). Planning to have these ready in August 2015. FAQ section on the website will be helpful.

Next month there will be a presentation on enforcement by Salt Lake County, Environmental Protection Division.
