## REPORT ITEMS

6. State of Utah Updates:
  - a. DWQ Programs and EPA by Jeff Studenka: *Jeff had another commitment today and couldn't make the meeting.*
  - b. Municipal Program by Rhonda Thiele: *Comment freely during the stakeholder period. Ask for clarity on requirements to understand them better. Employee named Francis Bernard, currently works for DEQ in pollution prevention, she will be working with municipalities to inspect their municipal facilities. She is not a regulator and is not reporting back to Rhonda or Jeanne. She may leave a checklist with action items to help the municipalities. She is available for one year before she retires, expecting her to be available around October, and may be able to reach all non-audited communities.*
  - c. Industrial Program by Mike George: *In St. George helping with the water fair. Harry Campbell mentioned that The Multi-Sector General Permit is up for renewal. Mike is hoping to wait for the EPA Multi-Sector General Permit prior to issuing the State of Utah Multi-Sector General Permit.*
  - d. Construction Program by Harry Campbell: *Francis Bernard is also available for construction and industrial sites. Working on Common Plan of Development General Permit and the Construction General Permit. Francis Bernards you can call her to help, she has helped with Industrial permits in the past. She has reached out in the past and there was no report that came back.*

*Several comments were submitted for the CPoD permit. It didn't clearly state that developers can carry over into homebuilding with the subdivision permit, and not take out permits on each*

- individual lot. Purpose was for small builders and builder/owners that don't do a lot of building. Working on the CPoD statement of basis as well as the other revised construction permit.*
- e. Storm Water Program by Jeanne Riley: *Working on the small MS4 permit renewal, and UDOT's permit renewal. Would love to hear from MS4s regarding presentation topics for the upcoming Stormwater Conference.*
  - f. Storm Water Program by Monique Rodriguez: *No report given.*
  - g. Groundwater Protection by Candace Cade or Brianna Ariotti: *Not present.*
7. USWAC Subcommittees Updates:
- a. Industrial: *Looking for volunteers for this subcommittee.*
  - b. Post Construction: *Preparing for a presentation in August, still receiving input from some sources.*
  - c. R.S.I. Program (see attached RSI Training Calendar): *Starting to catch up with the demand, last couple classes haven't been completely full like the previous classes. Question if the Walmart training program meets the qualified inspector requirement. Rhonda and Harry commented that this is up to the individual MS4s to allow it to qualify as certified or not. Contact Harry if you have any questions. Next RSI May 19<sup>th</sup> in Riverton, next then in Provo on June 3<sup>rd</sup>, then in St. George on June 29<sup>th</sup>.*
  - d. R.S.R. Program: *Met with Jeff and Harry to discuss the RSR program. Looking to retrofit the existing RSR program and restart the training shortly.*
  - e. Education and Training Program: *Nothing to report.*
8. APWA News and Updates: *APWA week next week. There's a golf tournament. Awards ceremony May 21<sup>st</sup> 2015. The APWA Utah Chapter will award the winners of the Storm Water Inspector of the Year and Storm Water Project of the Year.*
9. Stormwater Coalitions News and Updates:
- a. Cache County: *1,566 students during the 2 day water fair. Had good feedback from the teachers and students.*
  - b. Davis County: *Blake is no longer the chairman; he accepted a position with another City. The new chairman is Ted Parry with Fruit Heights. 1,500 students through water fair, new pamphlets were produced and are being distributed by the cities*
  - c. Salt Lake County: *Water Fair is being held today and tomorrow. It is the 9<sup>th</sup> water fair that they have held as a coalition. Expecting 2,500 students. New TV commercial being produced hopefully to be shown this fall. RSI class next week.*
  - d. Utah County: *Meeting tomorrow, meeting on how to organize a public education and outreach program.*

- e. Washington County: *Water Fair taking place today and tomorrow. Expecting 1,800 students to attend. Had RSI training with 10-15 attendees last month with another RSI training coming up in June and October.*
  - f. Weber County: *Held the water fair, had 1,000 students in attendance. Looking into doing future water fairs at the beginning of the school year rather than at the end of the year. Discussing how to do contractor training, CEU issue requirement. Subcommittee working on Public Outreach. Discussing a countywide hotline. Coalition received training on post-construction management by JUB.*
