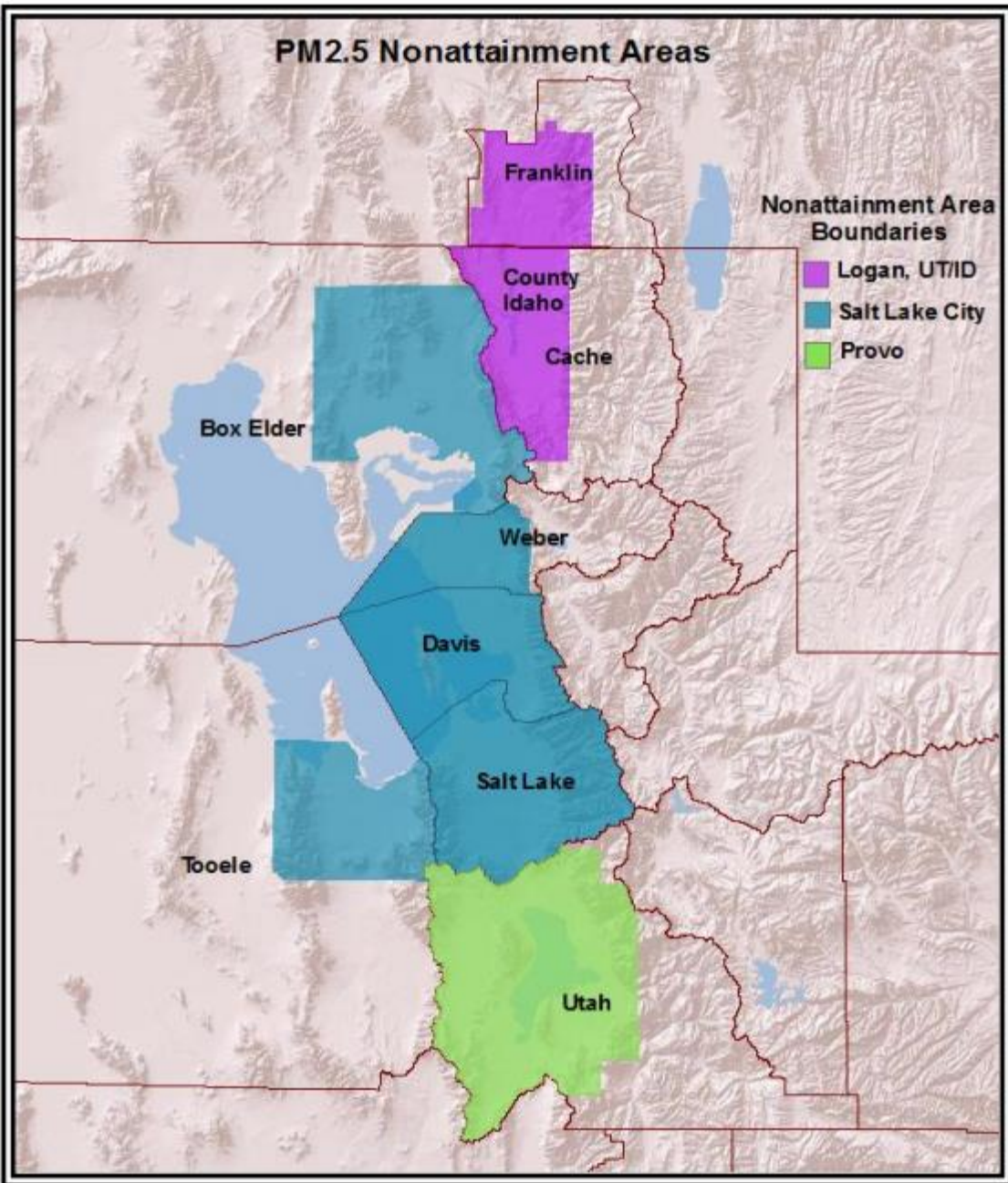

This web site provides online filing of your storm water permit and fugitive dust plan.

You will be required to establish an access account to file your initial application and/or subsequent modifications. If you have an existing Utah.gov account set up, you do not need to set-up a new account, you can use your existing Utah.gov account to log in to file your initial application.

The system will guide you through a series of qualifying questions to determine your applicability status and will guide you through the development of your applications.

CREATING A DUST PLAN

- The dust plan is free of charge.
- A typical dust plan can be made in 15-20 minutes.
- The dust plan is approved automatically.
 - Relevant activities are chosen by the applicant
 - Appropriate best management practices are picked for each activity.
- A pdf copy is given at the end of the program.
- All copies are saved in your account.
- If you really like our program, you can create a new dust plan every day of the year 😊

COMPLIANCE

- Dust plans received have gone from approximately one dozen per **year** in 2013 to a high last **month** of 214.
- The majority of compliance enforcements are taken from calls from the public.
- Typical DAQ response includes an initial phone call to the contact provided in the plan and then follow up visits as necessary.
- Enforcement is focused on keeping dust within the limits rather than discrepancies in the plan.
- A major component of the plan is considered educational.
- Plans are available for lookup by the general public
