Mission Statement: The Utah Storm Water Advisory Committee will coordinate efforts to reduce storm water pollution and provide adequate flood control. The committee will jointly review governing regulations, disseminate information to enhance compliance with those regulated, promote effective storm water management training, and assist local municipalities and other interested parties to implement best management practices, consistent with their individual needs and resources. The committee will also review any proposed storm water regulations to assess potential impacts on the regulated community.

  - a. Permitting options for the transition from site development to home construction.
    - i. If another owner takes over a development, then the new owner must take out a permit.. The original owner/permit holder must file an NOT if they sell the development.
    - ii. There was an example shown to address a partial sale of 1 or more lots of a development. Permit holder can email or call DWQ to remove certain lots as being completed, and the development must submit a partial NOT.
    - iii. Discussed common plan permit.
      1. Designed for owner/builders
      2. Only covers a single lot per NOI
      3. Same fee as CGP \$150 per year
      4. No certification required for inspections
      5. Shorter, easier to complete SWPPP template
      6. Shared controls are allowed under this section of the permit.
    - iv. CGP
      1. Must have an RSI or other certification for inspections. Covers multiple lots with one NOI
    - v. There are forms to cover a change in owner or change in contractor on the DWQ website.

- vi. If a development is complete, then additions to a lot (once the development has been completed), are not required to get a permit from the State unless it is over one acre.
- vii. Maximum amount of homes on a common plan of development is not specified. The common plan permit only covers one house.
- viii. If the overall plan does not develop more than one acre, then a state construction storm water permit would not be required.

### 6. State of Utah Updates:

#### a. Jeanne

- i. Small MS4 Permit has come off public notice
  - 1. They received two comments. One from EPA, one from the Home Builders
    - a. Will post comment responses to the website shortly.
- ii. Construction complaints are frequent in the Spring. MS4s are responsible for informing DWQ of any changes to their SWMP including storm water contacts.
- iii. Industrial Storm Water Template has been revised and is with the committee for review.
- iv. There will be a new release of the storm water database in April. Items to be fixed:
  - 1. NOI should be able to be downloaded
  - 2. MS4 list/ City lists will be updated.
  - 3. Common plan permits, UTRHXXXXX, is not expiring on June 30 as the database indicates.
  - 4. When permits expire, they are not moving to the expired phase. The 60 day grace period will be implemented.
- v. The CGP will expire June 30 of this year. Permittees who have obtained a permit after June 30, 2018 receive less than one year of coverage. DWQ is working on how to renew those covered after June 30.

- i. CGP is our for Stakeholder review. March 29 is the due date for stakeholder comments.
- ii. LID manual credit systems for groundwater recharge.

1. They have a groundwater recharge and recovery program, and you can recover water that has an associated water right.
